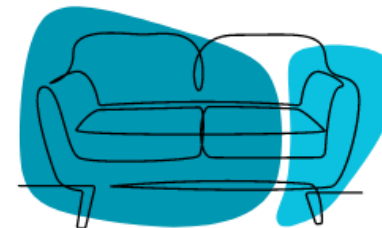
P.S. Our next "season" will run April 5- July31, 2025. Start thinking of a group you'd like to lead!

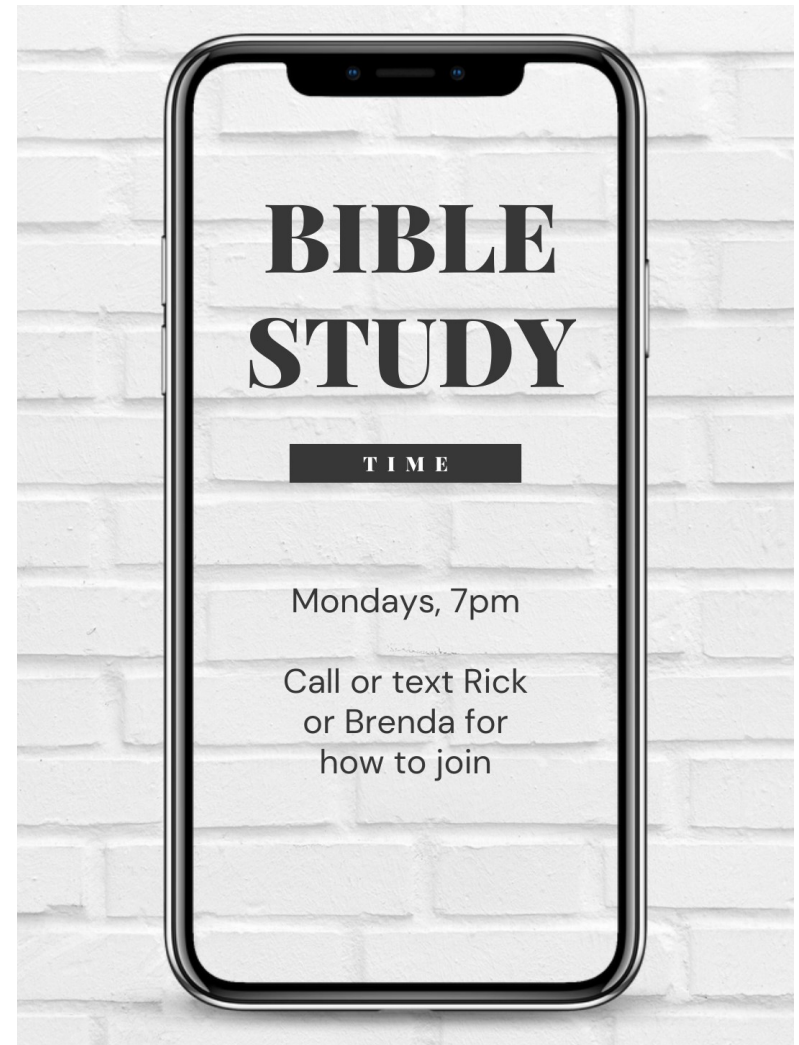

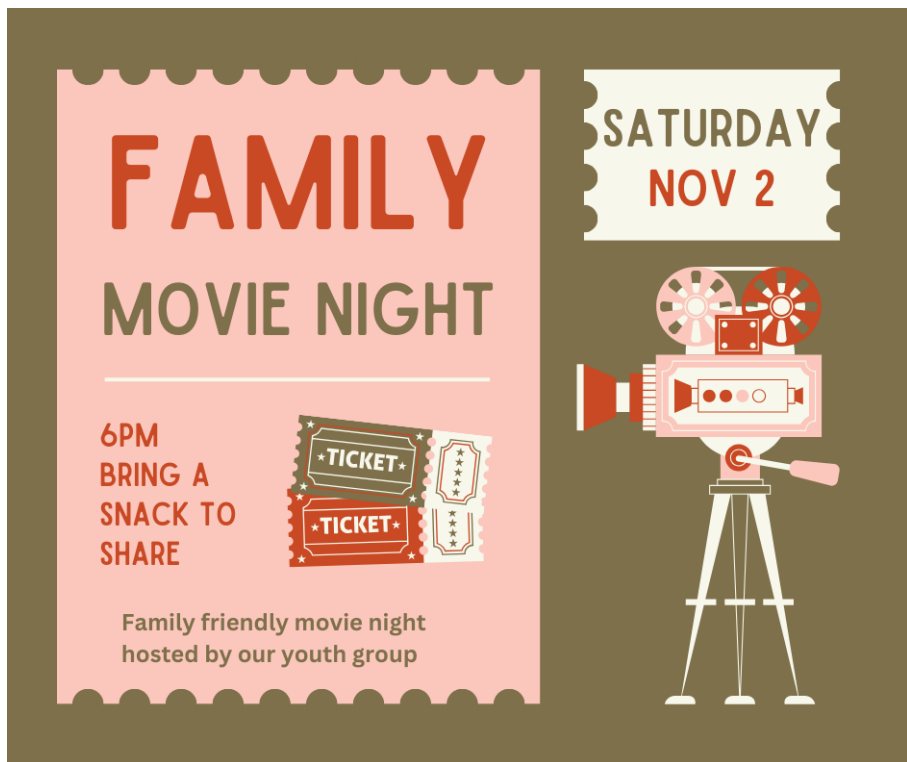
